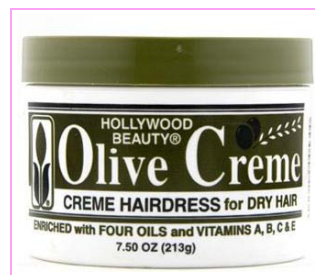

**The Truth:** I picked this up from my mother's room since it was just laying around, so I take it that she didn't really like it. Anyway, I tried it out on my hair (which has been straighter than normal since I did a roller set) for a few days now and I must say it's pretty good. It does not weigh my hair down (dipped 2 fingers in the jar only using a dime size amount per section) and it leaves my hair soft, provides a healthy glow/shine, feels incredibly smooth to the touch and moist. 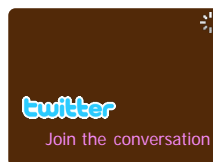

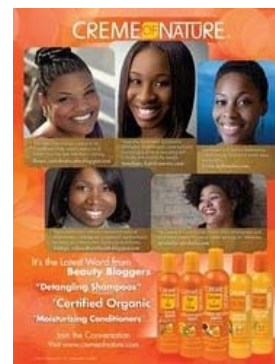

It's light green in color, has a creamy consistency but doesn't smell that great :-| I'm going to try it on my air dried hair and see if I like it too. Overall, so far so good! This could be a staple moisturizer for straight styles =]

**Tip #1** : Use a light weight oil to seal in moisture i.e. Coconut Oil (what I used), Grapeseed oil etc.

**Tip #2** : If you're suffering from dry ends, apply a small amount all over, paying close attention to your ends, then **baggy** for 2-3 hrs. You'll have soft & hydrated ends.

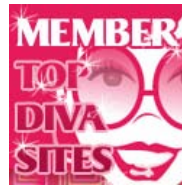
